The Liposome Research Days (LRD) Conferences started in 1990. The 5th and 11th LRD were held in Japan, in 1996 in Shizuoka, and in 2008 in Yokohama. LRD will be held in Sapporo, Japan in 2019. It will focus on all aspects of lipid and liposome research from basic research in biochemistry/biophysics to clinical application of nanoparticles.

Featured topics will include: drug delivery, nucleic acids/gene delivery, vaccines, imaging, microfluidics, new lipids, and clinical applications.

Innovations such as Patisiran[®], the first nucleic acid nanomedicine, based on innovative breakthrough lipid-based technology, is on the verge of being approved by the FDA and clinical applications of liposomal technologies will be hot issues at the Sapporo LRD.
